By signing up for the Call2Recycle program, NASSCO will receive special boxes to collect cell phone and rechargeable batteries for recycling. Once the boxes are full, Environmental Engineering will mail them back to the Call2Recycle headquarters for recycling.

To participate in the program, bring your used cell phone and rechargeable batteries to the Environmental Engineering Department on the 2nd floor of Building 8. Environmental engineers will assist you in the bagging and placing the batteries in the special Call2Recycle box for recycling.
